Chief Army Corps Engineers Wins State Engineering Achievement Award

(April 26, 2004, Frankfort, Kentucky): Marilyn Lewis, P.E., of Louisville, received the Kentucky Society of Professional Engineers (KSPE) Achievement in Government Award at the Society's 69th Annual Convention held at the Executive Inn in Owensboro, Kentucky, April 15-17, 2004.

Lewis, who is a member of the Louisville Chapter of KSPE, is involved in local and state programs for the Society, including the nationally renowned MATHCOUNTS program for middle school achievement in mathematics and Leadership P.E., of which she was a charter class member (1998). Leadership P.E. seeks to encourage, strengthen, and build the professional careers and civic involvement of entry- to mid-level engineers. Lewis is currently serving as chair of Leadership P.E. and participates as an instructor. She is also a member of the Society of American Military Engineers and National Society of Professional Engineers.

Lewis, who has worked mainly with the military program in a technical and a project-management capacity, is currently Chief-Environmental Engineering Branch of Engineering Division for the Corps of Engineers, Louisville District. She is responsible for selection and management of Architect-Engineer contracts for environmental studies and designs, as well as the development and procurement of remedial-action service contracts. She oversees a team of in-house professionals who perform a variety of environmental-related project functions.

A graduate of Tennessee Technological University with a Bachelor of Science degree in Civil Engineering, she received a Masters of Science in Engineering Administration from the University of Tennessee.

Founded in 1934, the Kentucky Society of Professional Engineers is a membership organization for professional engineers (P.E.s), professional land surveyors (P.L.S.s), engineers-in-training (E.I.T.s), and students pursuing careers in these and related areas.
